Contest Guidelines:

- The contest is open to all Texas public, private and home schooled students in grades 11-12.
- Only one poem relating to the theme *Prompts and Pathways* may be submitted.
- Entry must not exceed 25 lines, not counting the title.
- E-mailed entries must be in Microsoft Word (.doc) format, Times New Roman or Arial, size 12 font, double-spaced, minimum of one-inch margins on all sides.
- Paper entries should be typed on one side of the paper only.
- Originality and good taste in language and subject matter are required. Rough language and adult situations are to be avoided. Your name should not appear on the page of your entry.
- All entries shall be submitted by **April 18, 2019** with the required entry form.
- Submitted poems will be judged by a select committee of poets from the Poetry Society of Texas. Winning poems will be published in the 50th PST Conference anthology. Winners will be notified mid-May 2019. All entries become the property of Poetry Society of Texas.
