

# Call for Submissions: Poets Northwest 2023 Anthology

1. All members of Poets Northwest are eligible. Anyone who joins and pays their dues prior to the deadline is eligible. For membership information, go to <http://www.poetsnw.com/join.html>
2. The deadline is **Tuesday, July 18, 2023.**
3. The theme is Dreams and Nightmares. This can be literal or figurative.
4. Please send us 1 to 3 poems related to the theme – dreams and/or nightmares.
5. Previously published poems are acceptable. If published previously, let us know when and where it was published so we can include an acknowledgement.
6. By submitting work for the anthology, you affirm that it is your original work, did not use AI in any form in its creation, and you have the right to have the work printed or reprinted in the anthology.
7. Poets Northwest will produce eBook and paperback versions of the anthology but will not distribute the work in any other form without permission. You grant Poets Northwest the right to use your name and poem titles in promotional materials.
8. The maximum number of lines per poem is 42, not including a single line title, author byline, and blank line immediately following it. All other blank lines, epigraphs, footnotes, etc. are included in the line count. Please use Times New Roman 12pt.
9. Contributor copies can be pre-ordered at cost and will be distributed at a monthly meeting of Poets Northwest. If you are unable to attend, arrangements can be made to obtain your copies by mail or by some other means. Contributors will not receive any other compensation.
10. Include your name, address, email address, and phone number. Electronic submissions by email should be in a Microsoft Word format or plain text. Printed submissions should be on one-sided 8.5” x 11” white paper with black ink. All submissions should be single-spaced. Blank lines will be treated as stanza breaks.
